**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTER-NATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.**

Note: A recording fee of 50 cents and a \$3.00 per entry AKC Event fee is included in the entry fee, you do not have to add it as an additional fee.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

**Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There will be **no refunds** for duplicate entries.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class (except in case of wrong sex or age), nor can a dog be withdrawn after entries have closed. The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information of the entry blank.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

## **SHOW SITE INFORMATION:**

---

No Overnight Parking is allowed at show site, Thompson Park

The show grounds will be available to exhibitors at 8:00 am Monday September 5, 2022. No exhibitors may arrive prior to 8:00 am. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following the final judging.

Parking is on a first come - first served basis. All Parking is along the street. There are no RV reservations. Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged/moved. ONLY the Show Committee may reserve spaces to accommodate the se-up needs of the show. Extra spaces may not be saved by cones, chairs, x-pens, etc. by any exhibitors.

No generators are allowed.

The show grounds at this show constitute the rings and adjacent areas, grooming and crating areas and parking areas.

Grooming areas are under the supervision of the Grounds Committee who may require rearrangement of an exhibitor set up. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their crating/grooming areas.

No dumping of grey water.

The show committee may ask that unentered dogs be removed from the show grounds.

Dogs may not be tied to bushes, shrubs, trees or other permanent fixtures. No dogs in the restrooms. No dumping of dog food or grooming residue in restroom facilities.

All regulations regarding the use of this facility, and all regulation and decisions of the show giving committee at this show will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the information in this premium list.

Rocky Mountain Borzoi Club (RMBC), their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss damage or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to guests and/or children.

## **EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:**

---

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property while at or on the show grounds, or in transit to or from the show. And furthermore, assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form.  
Agent names to be included in catalog if provided and they are not an owner/co-owner.

All persons entering this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against Show giving club, it's members or the show secretary in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates/setup area. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs AT ALL TIMES.

Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety. This is for the safety of your child and will be enforced.

Rocky Mountain Borzoi Club may decline any entry for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on-account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against Rocky Mountain Borzoi Club or any official thereof.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal; and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have proper vaccinations.

## **SWEEPSTAKES**

Open to all Borzoi 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show, Entrants must NOT be a Champion of Record as of the date of closing. All entries must be entered in a Regular Class in this Show.

Entry fee is **\$25.00** for Sweepstakes and is in addition to the entry fee for the Regular Classes. Entry is to be made on the same official entry form and be marked Sweeps (and state age) under Additional Classes.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

6 Mo & Under 9 Mo      9 Mo & Under 12 Mo      12 Mo & Under 15 Mo      15 Mo & Under 18 Mo

## **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

The Veteran Sweepstakes are open to all Borzoi who are 7 years of age and older. They may be spayed or neutered and do not have to be entered in any other class at this show. Entry fee is **\$25.00** for each Veteran entered in Sweepstakes. Entry is to be made on the same official entry form and be marked Veteran Sweeps (and state age class) under Additional Classes.

Note: Winners of these classes are not eligible for Best of Breed competition unless they are entered in Best of Breed or qualify by winning Veterans or WD/WB Classes.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

7 years and under 10 years      10 years and older

### **DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES for above Sweepstakes**

30% of total fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 70% will be divided as follows:

## **THE DUAL CHAMPION STAKES**

The Dual Champion Stakes is open to any AKC Borzoi Breed Champion with one of the following verifiable titles: AKC Field Champion, ASFA Field Champion, LGRA Straight Racing Champion, NOTRA Oval Racing Champion, Open Field Coursing Champion.

Additional Entry Requirements: Each dog entered must also be entered in a conformation class (BOB or Veteran). All entries with titles other than AKC will need to send a copy of documentation of titles with entry. Enter in the "Additional Class" on entry form. Entry Fee is \$20.00, dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Classifications for Dogs and Bitches  
Young Adult - 1 year and under 3 years of age  
Mature Adult - 3 years and under 7 years of age  
Veteran - 7 years and under 10 years of age  
Veteran - 10 years of age and older.

### **DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES for Dual Champion Stakes**

35% of total fees will be retained by the Club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be divided as follows:

## **4-to-6 Month Beginner Puppy**

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Class will not be divided by sex

**\*this is a new option offered by AKC, entrants are not eligible for Best Puppy in regular class.**

**Best of Breed:** Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries for this show, may be transferred from the regular class to the Best of Breed competition provided this transfer is made by the show secretary at least one hour prior to the start of judging for this show. (AKC Rule Chapter 11, Section 6)

## NON-REGULAR CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

**VETERAN DOG/BITCH CLASS\*** - A class for Dogs/Bitches seven (7) years and older

Veteran classes will be divided by age for both dogs and bitches: 7 years and under 10 years, 10 years and older

\*Winners of the Veterans classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition if otherwise undefeated at this show. Castrated males and spayed bitches are eligible for this class.

As a symbol of respect to those Veterans who honor us with their presence, only one dog and one bitch from each class will be selected to receive the 1<sup>st</sup> place award of a Pink Rosette, all others will be considered runners-up and will receive a Maroon Rosette.

**BEST VETERAN details:** For first place winners in the non-regular Veteran classes (dog & bitch).

### **BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES details**

For first place winners in the regular puppy classes - (6-9) dog & bitch and (9-12) dog & bitch. Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy winners are not eligible for this class.

**BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR details:** For first place winners in all the Bred by Exhibitor classes (dog & bitch).

**BEST OWNER HANDLER:** Same rules as AKC National Owner Handled Series but this is **not part of the National Series**. Please check the Eligibility box on entry form. See reference to rules on page 9.

## NON-REGULAR CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

**3<sup>rd</sup> GENERATION CLASS:** A Grandsire/Granddam and one of his/her get/produce and one get/produce from his/her get/produce will be shown together as a unit. At least one of the two succeeding generations must be entered in the regular classes of the show. The class is to be judged based on the consistency of the generations.

**TROIKA CLASS:** A Troika Class entry would consist of 3 Borzois that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of three handlers. The 3 Borzois competing in Troika Class must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Troika must be named at the time of entry. In making entries full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class mark as an Additional Class.

**BRACE CLASS** - A Brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. In making entries full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class mark as an Additional Class.

**STUD DOG CLASS-** For Stud Dogs and two-four (2-4) of their Get. Get must be entered in regular class at this show. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under AKC Dog Show Rules. Neutered dogs are allowed in this class. In making entries full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class mark as an Additional Class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS-** For Brood Bitches and two-four (2-4) of their Get. Get must be entered in regular class at this show. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification under AKC Dog Show Rules. Spayed bitches are allowed in this class. In making entries full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. If the dog is entered in another class mark as an Additional Class.

**Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner\*. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years.*
