DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

4500 Private Rd 162, Elizabeth, CO 80107

(Second house on the left, white with black trim)

From Castle Rock:

Take Hwy 86 through Franktown and through the town of Elizabeth. At the top of the hill--turn left/north on County Rd 21. Go north on CR 21 for 5.7 miles to Private Rd 162. Turn left/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Castle Pines:

Take Hess Rd east --will turn into Hilltop ~1 mile after crossing Parker Road-- stay on for another 4-5 miles to Singing Hills (can only turn left/east). Stay on Singing Hills east for approx. 7 miles (past 2 four-way stops) to County Rd 21 (First right after the second four-way stop). Can only turn right/south at CR 21. Go 1 mile south to Private Rd 162. Turn right/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Parker:

Parker Road/Hwy 83 to Hess Rd. Left/east on Hess Rd-- will turn into Hilltop after about a mile--stay on for another 4-5 miles to Singing Hills (can only turn left/east again). Stay on Singing Hills east for approx. 7 miles (past 2 four-way stops) to County Rd 21 (First right after the second four-way stop). Right/south at CR 21. Go 1 mile south to Private Rd 162. Turn right/west on PR 162 (dirt road).

From Colorado Springs:

(I-25) North to Castle Rock (Wilcox exit) North to Hwy 86. East on 86 through Franktown to Elizabeth. Continue through Elizabeth-- look for County Rd 21 at the top of the hill on your way out of Elizabeth. Left (North) on CR 21 for 5.7 miles to Private Rd 162. Left (west) on Private Rd 162 (dirt road). You can also come up from Colorado Springs on Hwy 83 to Franktown, then turn right (west) on Hwy 86 to Elizabeth and continue. More scenic and usually less traffic.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTER-NATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, (unless replaced by an alternate), disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Chair..

Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Bitches in season are not allowed in Farm Dog Certification Tests.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Trial/Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Trial Secretary.
Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

Entries must be made on an included AKC entry form or photocopy of the Official AKC entry form with the Agreement and Rules or they cannot be accepted.

Confirmation of Entry will be sent to the email address(s) on the Official AKC entry form within 48 hours of receipt, if you do not receive email confirmation promptly please contact Trial secretary. Judging Schedule will be sent after close of entries.

Disaster and Emergency Plans for People and Dogs at this Herding Event

- **Fire:** Dial 911. All dogs should be crated or leashed securely. Owners, Handlers and Spectators must keep the main driveway clear so Emergency vehicles will have suitable access to the property.
- **Thunderstorms and Lightning:** Should lightning be observed, all people and dogs should move to the safety of their vehicles or covered buildings until the danger has passed.
- **Mass Disaster Plan – Tornado:** In the event of a tornado, dogs should be leashed and all people and their dogs should proceed to the lowest point on the property until the danger has passed.
- **Personal Injury or Health Problems:** Dial 911 for the Emergency Response Team/Ambulance, or see above.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when working the trial/test. Under NO circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere from outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to person or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club Herding Regulations)

All AKC rules regarding conduct will be strictly enforced.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Trial Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents on progression of Judging. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at the trial site and appropriate arena.**

The trial hosting Club, the Trial Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property while at or on the trial grounds, or in transit to or from the trial. And furthermore assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

The hosting club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the club, site or Trial secretary will be responsible for any injury, damage, or loss. It is understood that all dogs at this trial are in the care and custody of the owners or owner's agents during the entire trial weekend.

There shall be no drilling or intensive /abusive training of dogs on the Trial/Test grounds.

Exhibitors are required to clean up after the dogs that they are trialing or which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the arena or at any location on our trial site. Clean up tools and supplies will be available, see Trial Secretary if needed.

Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times, for their own safety.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Trial/Test Committees of these trial giving clubs on this day will be strictly enforced, including and not recorded in this Premium List.

All persons entering this dog trial/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against The Greater Swiss Mountain Dog Club of the Rockies, it's members or the Trial secretary in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. The club(s) is solely responsible for determining if the said animal is in distress.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) will pay for any injuries or the replacement value in the event of serious injury to the livestock caused by my (our) dog. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION.
