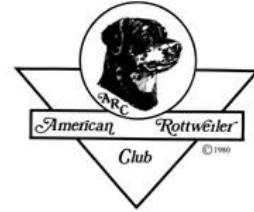

- o Sheep – Mixed breed sheep (value \$300 each)
 - Course A – 3-5 head of stock per run depending on entries
- o Ducks – Mixed breed ducks (value \$75 each)
 - Course A - 5 head of ducks per run
- o Cattle – Mixed breed cattle (market value)
 - Course A – 3-5 head of stock per run depending on entries
- o Goats value \$300, used for PT, HT

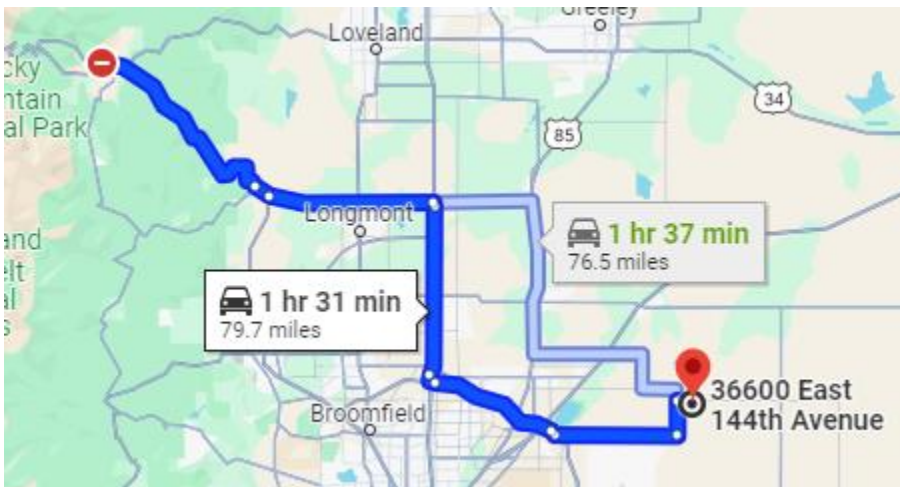
