CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

A judging schedule will be mailed to each entrant as soon as practical after closing of entries. For information concerning entries, the Show Secretary can be contacted by phone: (719) 338-0065 or by e-mail: chdogevents@aol.com

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.

No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. There will be **no refunds** for duplicate entries. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class (except in case of wrong sex), nor can a dog be withdrawn after entries have closed. The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information of the entry blank.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entries must be made on an Official AKC entry form or photocopy of the Official AKC entry form with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side or they cannot be accepted.

Confirmation of Entry will be sent to the email address(s) on the Official AKC entry form within 48 hours of receipt. If you do not receive email confirmation promptly please contact show secretary. Confirmation of Entry and Judging Schedule will be sent via postal mail to the address on the on Official AKC entry form after the closing date, unless otherwise agreed to in email notification.

SHOW SITE INFORMATION:

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 4:00pm to 10:00pm on Wednesday August 31, 2022. Thursday and Friday September 1-2, 2022 from 7:00am to 10:00pm

The show grounds constitute the building & the outside grounds and parking lot.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of this show giving club on this day will be strictly enforced, including and not recorded in this Premium List.

Exercise pens can be set up according to socially distancing requirements in force at the time of the show.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs AT ALL TIMES. Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks and toilets is strictly prohibited!

NO dogs will be allowed in the restrooms. NO un-entered dogs allowed on the show grounds.

No baby strollers are allowed in the show buildings.

Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety.

The Show Committee will exercise its right to suspend any person from all AKC privileges for conduct prejudicial to the best interests of purebred dogs which includes abuse of a motel/hotel facility (Chapter 7, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Registration & Discipline*).

Some hotels have a limit on the number of dogs accepted. When making reservations, please inquire into dog fees and tell them you are in town for the dog show to be eligible for dog show rates, if applicable. Please see our host hotel information for rates and additional information.

You are **REQUIRED** to clean up the area after walking your dogs at any hotel/motel. **DO NOT** leave dogs unattended inside any motel room or groom your dog inside any room.

Please use exercise pens if provided.

All parks and the lawns at the Greeley Tribune Building and Lincoln Park are OFF LIMITS to dogs except Island Grove. Violators in Lincoln Park may be ticketed.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class.
Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property while at or on the show grounds, or in transit to or from the show. And furthermore, assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

The hosting club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the club, site or show secretary will be responsible for any injury, damage, or loss. It is understood that all dogs at this show are in the care and custody of the owners or owner's agents during the entire show weekend.

No double handling will be permitted at these shows. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

No generators to be operated within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.

There shall be no drilling or intensive /abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth in the official AKC entry form for this event.

Dogs must be in control at all times. Please note: AKC Board Policy Special training devices that are used to control and train dogs, including but not limited to, collars with prongs, electronic collars used with transmitters, muzzles and head collars may not be used on dogs at AKC events, except as allowed in the AKC Rules, Regulations, and policies.

Exhibitors are required to clean up after the dogs that they are exhibiting, or which are under their care or control. This requirement includes both while in the ring or at any location on our show site. Clean up tools and supplies will be available at each ring and at other convenient locations through-out the show grounds.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

All persons entering this dog show/event, hereby waive any claim for damages against the Rocky Mountain Irish Wolfhound Club, it's members or the show secretary in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation. The club(s) is solely responsible for determining if the said animal is in distress.

REGULAR CLASSES

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Puppy, 6 mo & under 9 mo	Bred-by-Exhibitor
Puppy, 9 mo & under 12 mo	American-Bred
12 mo & under 15 mo	Open
15 mo & under 18 mo	
Novice*	Winners, Best of Breed

*(please verify eligibility before entering)

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-hour prior to the start of the judging at this show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS: All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC, the person handling the dog must be a breeder of record and an owner or co-owner of the dog

NON-REGULAR CLASSES – Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG / BITCH CLASS* - A class for dogs/bitches six (6) years and older
Veteran classes will be divided by age for both dogs and bitches:
6 years and under 8 years & 8 years and older

FIELD TRIAL DOGS / BITCHES*: All entries in these classes must have earned an AKC Field Championship: ASFA Field Championship; LCM or Senior Courser Title.

*1st place winners of the above Veteran and Field Trial classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed IF undefeated in any other class at this show.

BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES – For 1st place winners of dog/bitch 6-9 month and 9-12 month classes

BEST ENTRY IN VETERAN CLASSES – For 1st place winners from dog/bitch Veteran classes

FOLLOWING THE SELECTION OF BEST ENTRY IN VETERAN CLASSES THERE WILL BE A PRESENTATION OF A SPECIAL RECOGNITION GIFT TO THE OLDEST VETERAN ENTERED IN THIS RMIWA SPECIALTY**IW Metal Art & Rosette**

NON-REGULAR CLASSES – Involving Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS*- For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owners of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owners of the Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. The winner of this class will not be eligible for Best of Breed competition by virtue of having won this class. Get must be entered in one of the regular classes. Neutered dogs are allowed in this class.

BROOD BITCH CLASS*- For Brood Bitches and two of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owners of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owners of the Produce. Produce, only to be judged, based on the merits of the Produce. The winner of this class will not be eligible for Best of Breed competition by virtue of having won this class. Produce must be entered in one of the regular classes. Spayed bitches are allowed in the class.

BRACE*- For two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers, with at least one common owner. Both dogs in the Brace must be entered in another class at this show.

TEAM* - For four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of four handlers, with at least one common owner. All dogs in the Team must be entered in another class at this show.

*No one of the dogs or bitches making up the above entries that were judged first will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these Non-regular classes.

CLASS INFORMATION

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP – Thursday Only

- NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.
- OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.
- OPEN SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.
- MASTER CLASS** - (*effective date of January 1, 2018*) For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) Best Junior wins with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season or a veterinarian's excuse may be replaced by another dog meeting the same ownership requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form.

Obedience/Rally Move Ups

The provisions for transfers in the Obedience and Rally Regulations were established to allow a dog to be transferred to another class, from which it was originally entered after entries have closed, if the dog has earned a title. The dog and handler must be eligible for the class they are requesting to transfer into.

Transfers and Move Ups will be accepted at these Obedience and Rally Trials.

Transfers from an "A" to "B" class at the same level are allowed.

A written request for transfer can be submitted to Trial Secretary anytime up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

SWEEPSTAKES – Friday Only

SWEEPSTAKES - REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

Puppy - Open to all Irish Wolfhound 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. Entrants may be shown by owners or agents. A Champion of Record* as of the date of closing will not be eligible. All entries must be entered in a Regular Class in this Show.

*No dog that has completed requirements for a Championship shall be eligible for the Sweepstakes Classes. Any dog attaining its Championship Title (confirmed or unconfirmed) after the closing of this show must be withdrawn. **Entry Fees will not be refunded.**

Veteran – Open to all Irish Wolfhounds 6 years or older on the day of the show. Entrants may be shown by owners or agents. All entries must be entered in a Regular Class in this Show.

Entry fee is **\$20.00** for each Irish Wolfhound entered in Sweepstakes and is in addition to the entry fee for the Regular Classes. Enter in writing "Sweepstakes" under Additional Classes on entry form, including additional fee.

Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular classes.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

- Junior, 6 Mo & Under 9 Mo
- Junior, 9 Mo & Under 12 Mo
- Senior, 12 Mo & Under 15 Mo
- Senior, 15 Mo & Under 18 Mo

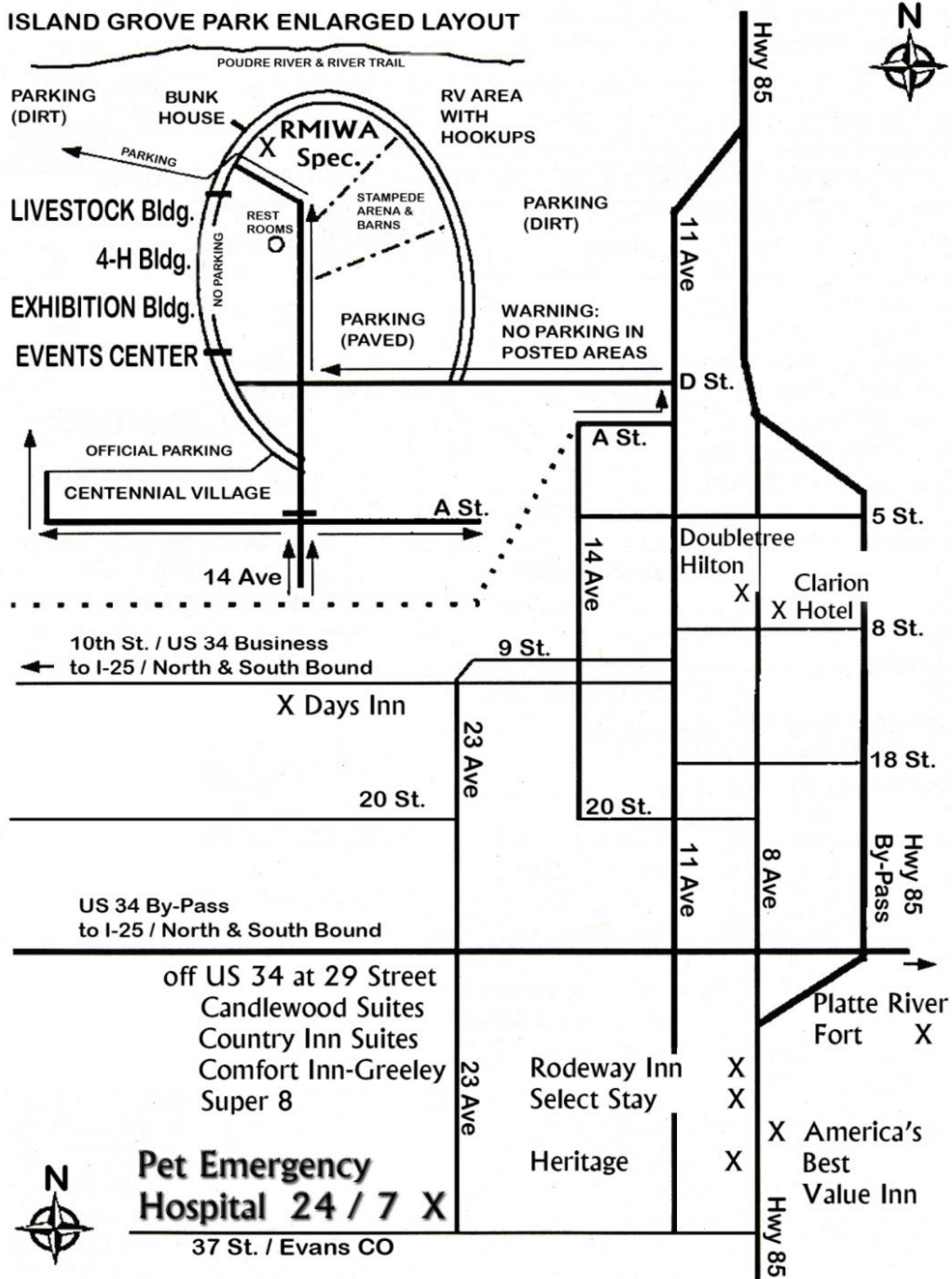
